Fireworks Sales

We will start selling fireworks at Bressner Hall on Tuesday, June 27th. Remember that the profit from the sale of fireworks goes into a scholarship fund for 4-H members. Be enthusiastic and sell, sell, SELL! Greet your customers with a friendly hello and give them a box to put their fireworks in as they shop. Work schedules were selected at the last 4-H Council meeting and are as follows:

When working on your club schedule for the sale, pair new families with more experienced ones.

- * If you are the first one to open Bressner for the day, you will need to put out the flags. Flags are mounted on white pipe that slides over the T-post along the highway.
- * You will also need to put the open signs outside. If you close the stand in the evening, you will need to bring flags

back in to the hallway and bring in the open signs. Make sure **ALL** doors are locked before you leave.

- * Do not prop outside doors open! The air conditioner is on!
- * Keep kitchen door locked.
- * If you are eating in the building, do so in the kitchen area and clean up your mess.
- * Do not allow anyone to shoot fireworks close to the building.
- * If you have a smart phone, most of the fireworks signs have an app that allows you to see what that item does.
- * If there is no vehicle around the building, most people will think the stand is closed, regardless of the "open" signs outside.

- * Have fun! Be patient with your customers, and offer to help them. Be sure to thank them for supporting the 4-H Scholarship program!

Families will need to pick up the money bag and the key to Bressner Hall if they are scheduled to start the day. For those working Saturday or Sunday, the bag and key will need to be picked up on Friday. At the end of each day, the money bag (with the key in it) should be put in the night deposit box at Piqua State Bank.

While at Bressner, 4-H'ers are also encouraged to put newer photos in the 4-H Club frames on the wall.

Favorite Foods Show & Consumer Judging Contest

Don't forget about the Favorite Foods Show being held on Tuesday, June 13. It will start at 10:00 at Bressner Hall. Details and the registration form were in the May newsletter - please call the office if you need another copy sent to you.

There will also be a Consumer Judging Contest at the Extension Office that same day. 4-H'ers can participate between 9:00 - 11:30 a.m. or 1:00 - 4:30 p.m.

Top placings in both the Favorite Foods Show and the Consumer Judging Contest will be able to go on and compete at the area shows and contests.

It's Almost Fair Time!

The County Fair will be July 15 - 19. You may pick up entry forms, food bags, photo mats, etcetera, any time. There are some projects that require a “pre-entry” for the fair. These forms are available at the Extension office or online on the “4-H” page of our county website: www.woodson.ksu.edu. Projects included for pre-entry are Foods & Nutrition, Visual Arts (Arts & Crafts), Clothing Construction, Style Revue, Rocketry, Robotics, Horse, Beef, Bucket Calf, Sheep, Swine, Goats, Poultry and Rabbits, as well as Open Class Livestock, Poultry and Rabbits. Some entries require signatures, so be sure to read closely. **ALL PRE-ENTRIES ARE DUE JULY 6!**

FAIR SET-UP AND CLEAN-UP ASSIGNMENTS

- Set-up:** 3-In-1: Bressner Hall and Poultry Building;
Piqua: 4-H Building upstairs and downstairs;
Eager Beavers: Livestock barns and show barn.
- Clean-up:** 3-In-1: Bressner Hall and basement of 4-H Building;
Piqua: move chairs/tables from show arena and clean up Poultry building;
Eager Beavers: Pick up trash on entire fair rounds, saddle club arena and clean up livestock barns.

ALL livestock exhibitors are required to clean out their own assigned pens. All pens need to be cleaned and all saw dust or shavings removed. This can be done after the sale is over or the next day prior to clean-up. **ALL 4-H members are expected to help on Wednesday, July 19th at 12:30 p.m.** to set up the sale arena and take down exhibits in the 4-H Community Building and re-set up chairs and tables for the buyers and exhibitors meal.

CLUB WATCHES FOR BRESSNER AND 4-H COMMUNITY BUILDING

TUESDAY EVENING ACTIVITIES

ONLY 4-H and FFA members that are exhibiting in the 2107 Woodson County Fair are allowed on the fairgrounds after 11:00p.m. Everyone that spends the night is expected to help with the Wednesday afternoon activities at 12:30.

HELPERS DURING PREMIUM SALE

Each club needs to make sure that they have 2 members to help serve iced tea and water to our buyers during the pre-

mium sale. Members need to be there to help between 7:00 - 9:00pm during the sale on Wednesday, July 19th. Please let the Extension Office know who those individuals will be.

PHOTOGRAPHY (4-H and Open Class) DIVISION UPDATE: Videos are no longer a part of the Photography Division. **PHOTOGRAPHY PROJECT MEMBERS** will be allowed to enter three photos at the county fair. County fair rules require photographs be mounted on photo boards which may be picked up at the Extension office for \$1.25 each. With the photo boards will be a special bag in which to display the photo, and paper for your name and photograph class. Instructions will also be included.

THE WOODSON COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE will offer cash prizes for the best pictures that depict “life in Woodson County”.

FOOD & NUTRITION PROJECT MEMBERS should know that commercial frostings are acceptable on their projects requiring frosting. Home canned foods must follow Food Preservation rules and use tested recipes. Make sure that canning jars used are clear and not tinted.

LIVESTOCK SHOWS AND SALE

When participating in the livestock shows and Premium Sale, 4-H’ers are required to wear a white shirt and blue jeans. If you have told us that you will be participating in showmanship, you are expected to do so. A list of showmanship participants and their T-shirt sizes is attached to this letter. Corrections need to be sent to Andrea no later than Friday, June 16. Sponsors donate T-shirts and prizes and the shirts should not go to waste.



More Fair Information

POULTRY TESTING

All poultry being shown at the fair must be tested for pullorum. This will be done at the fairgrounds on July 10th, starting at 10:00 a.m. This is **required** for all birds.

HORSE SHOW REQUIREMENTS

In order to show a horse at the fair, you **must** have a non Coggins report from your veterinarian that has been done in the current calendar year of the county fair (after Jan. 1, 2017). Failure to have the report will result in not being able to show the horse.

FAIR JUDGING SCHEDULE

The Foods and Arts & Crafts schedules will be posted at fair set-up July 12th. Be sure to check the schedule so that you can be on time for judging. Sign up for your woodworking conference judging time when you enter your woodworking projects as well as conference judging for photography. Photography judging will begin at noon on Monday, July 17. Keep the arts & crafts judging schedule in mind as you are signing up for the photography conference schedule.

CLOTHING JUDGING, STYLE REVUE AND CONSUMER JUDGING

Clothing judging, style revue, and consumer judging will take place on Thursday, July 13th. It will begin at 8:30 a.m. at the New York Valley Church. We are trying to have all the buymanship and construction judging done in the morning, running into the lunch hour if need be. The final judging schedule will be forwarded to those enrolled in the clothing projects sometime after July 7th.

A consumer judging contest will be held during the clothing judging on a come-and-go basis on July 13th at the church. This will begin at 9:00 a.m.

The Public Style Revue will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 15th in the Community Building.



Ugly Feed Truck Contest

Get in the world-wide spirit and bring your ugly feed truck to town to drive in the parade on Monday, July 17. The more dents, rust, baling wire, and peeling paint, the better!
