4-H Favorite Foods Show

4-H'ers enrolled in the Food and Nutrition project will have an opportunity to exhibit a favorite food that they have learned to prepare at the Favorite Foods Show on Tuesday, June 13th at the 4-H Community Building.

To exhibit at the show, 4-H'ers must:

1. Choose a theme for their table.
2. Select a favorite recipe from one of the following groups: main dishes, salads, sandwiches, vegetables, snacks, drinks, fruits, desserts, or breads.
3. On the day of the show:
 - A. Exhibit your prepared favorite food. A refrigerator, oven and microwave will be available. Your dish should be ready.
 - B. Bring your recipe of your favorite food handwritten or typed on a 3x5 card.
 - C. Display a menu of what might be

served with your favorite food. In the past, some have used picture frames to display their menus.

D. Exhibit the above mentioned items on a table, which will be provided, with an appropriate table setting (cloth, dishes, silverware) and centerpiece.

Participants need to be able to tell the judge how to prepare and serve the food; why this food makes a difference to good health; and why the dishes, cloth, silverware, and centerpiece was selected. The judge may or may not test the food.

The top two exhibitors in the junior and senior divisions will be eligible to compete at the SE Area Favorite Foods Show later in June.

Food and Nutrition members should watch their email for additional details about the show.

Take Note of This Info

It's time to start thinking about camp! Youth who have completed 3rd through 7th grade are eligible to attend camp at Rock Springs 4-H Center June 24 - 27.

Camping creates memories of fun-filled days. Attending summer camp can be a time for experiencing nature and the outdoors, making new friends, and learning life skills. Summer camp is more than just a vacation. Campers learn self-confidence, cooperation with others, and how to live in different communities.

As for the fun parts? There's canoeing, exploring, fishing, disc golf, archery, crafts, campfires, and more!

The cost to attend camp is \$200. Registration is due at the Extension office by May 16.

Livestock Nominations

June 15 is the deadline for nominations for the Kansas Junior Livestock Show and the Kansas State Fair. Lambs, pigs, meat goats, and commercial crossbred heifers must be nominated.

Lambs must be nose printed, pigs need to be ear notched, meat goats, and all commercial breeding heifers need to be tagged. Nominations are not required for registered breeding heifers or registered breeding ewes.

All nominations are \$8/head this year. The fee is submitted with the required household nomination form, which is available online or at the Extension office.

Remember, **club members**, you have to attend 60% of your club meetings to be eligible to show at the fair.

✍️ **4-H Council** will meet at the Extension office on **May 24**, at 7:00. All council members and leaders need to plan to attend. This will be the last meeting before the county fair, so there will be lots of things on the agenda. The fireworks schedule as well as club fair schedules will be set.

✍️ There will be a **Consumer Judging Contest** on Tuesday, June 13 at the Extension office. 4-H'ers can come and go as they please between 9:00 - 11:30 or 1:00 - 4:30.
