EXAMPLE OF COMPLETE DESCRIPTION: Paige Crawford strolls along in her three piece casual spring ensemble. Her natural colored cotton tee has a simple round neck with short sleeves. The pleated khaki walking shorts have slash pockets and a front zipper. To set off the outfit, Paige has chosen a slate blue cotton vest with patch pockets, and wooden buttons which compliment the natural look. The outfit is easy to care for, being machine washable and dryable.

Paige's brown leather sandals, belt and watchband compliment her outfit. A gold chain and loveknot earrings complete her ensemble.

This versatile outfit can be interchanged to dress it up or down for occasions ranging from picnics to banquets.
